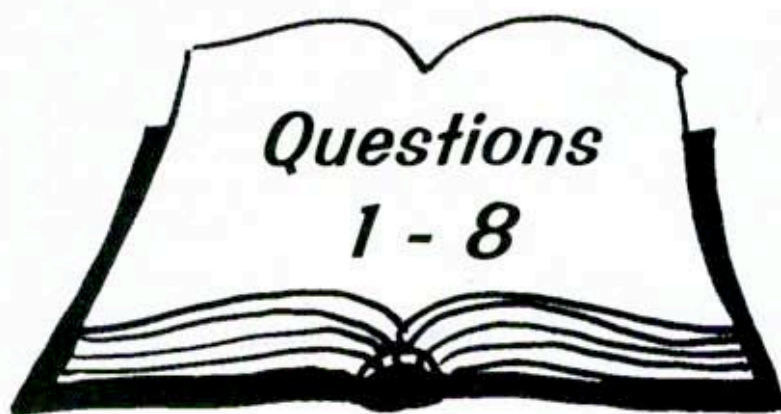


God answers our questions in his special book, the Bible. *The Big Book Of Questions and Answers* will help you to find out what his answers are.
