4. Read 2 Chronicles 19:4–7. How did the character of God affect Jehoshaphat’s view of life in what should be done and how things should be done?
5. As you read the heart of Jehoshaphat’s prayer in 2 Chronicles 20:12, what is its initial appeal that draws you into it?
